

## Curriculum Vitae: Patrick Cavanagh

- Co-Director, Dispute Resolution Centre, Bond University (1990-current) teaching over 350 programs on negotiation, mediation and arbitration skills in Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore and Indonesia.
- Adjunct Associate Professor of Law, Bond University (2002-current) teaching Advanced Commercial Negotiation.
- Senior Case Manager/Senior Mediator with Jakarta Initiative Task Force (JITF) based in Jakarta Indonesia (2001-2003). This was a USAID/World Bank program that mediated debt restructuring issues between domestic borrowers and syndicated foreign lenders. The program assisted with disputes that had a minimum outstanding debt of US\$10 million. The average amount in dispute was US\$250 million. The JITF successfully mediated the resolution of US\$21 billion of outstanding loans. In addition to acting as mediator my responsibilities included training and certification of mediators both internally and in the wider public/private corporate area.
- Senior Advisor to National Mediation Centre (PMN) Jakarta Indonesia. This is the first commercial mediation organisation established in Indonesia. Assumed responsibility for the drafting and implementation of mandatory civil court annexed mediation programmes together with associated judicial training and certification and accreditation schemes for commercial and court appointed mediators.
- Appointed as specialist mediation advisor to Government of Indonesia to assist resolution of US\$1.5 billion telecommunications dispute.
- Associate Professor of Law at Bond University (1990-2002) teaching Torts, Business Law, Business Associations, Construction Law and Dispute Resolution, Mediation and Negotiation to both undergraduate and postgraduate classes.
- Commercial mediator specialising in Federal multi-party litigation. These have been class actions or multi-party franchise disputes.
- Involved as either a mediator/administrator in over 500 mediations, involving commercial disputes throughout Australia, New Zealand and Indonesia.
- Mediator under Retail Shop Leases Act (Qld) 1994. This position involves the mediation of civil disputes between commercial landlords and lessees.
- Principal "Mediation and Negotiation Services Pty Ltd". This consultancy involves the providing of commercial mediation/negotiation services to the commercial community.
- Accredited Mediator and specialist trainer for National Electricity Code Administrator Limited.
- Lecturer (Adjunct) Queensland University, Law School (Appointed 2000), lecturing in Advanced Commercial Negotiation.
- Member, Queensland Law Society, Dispute Resolution Committee (1999-2001).
- Disputes Manager with Bar Association of Queensland (1990-1995). This position involved the promotion of Dispute Resolution procedures to the Australian commercial community and the implementation of arbitration mediation and expert appraisal procedures.
- Executive Director, Queensland Settlement Week, 1992-1995. This position involved the promotion of court annexed mediation programs that were sponsored by both the public and private sector. This program was the forerunner of similar schemes adopted in other Australian states.
- National Manager, Australian Commercial Disputes Centre, Sydney (1986-1989). This position involved the promotion of dispute resolution procedures to the Australian commercial community in an organisation that was the original promoter and supplier of dispute resolution procedures in Australia.
