

Manipulation of SMS messages

10. As noted in our first report, the Ashby iPhone had not been "jailbroken", which in turn means that direct access to the SMS messages on the Ashby iPhone would be blocked by the Apple operating system (IOS). This in turn makes any manipulation of the SMS messages contained therein problematic.
11. To circumvent this restriction without the need to "jailbreak" the phone, it is possible to back up the iPhone using Apple's iTunes software and then manipulating the SMS messages within the backup, restoring the modified backup to the iPhone. This approach does not require the iPhone to be "jailbroken".
12. The remainder of this report details our examination of the SMS message database contained on the Ashby iPhone for signs of modification via the backup and restore method.

Overview of how SMS messages are stored in the Ashby iPhone

13. Communications such as SMS messages, MMS messages and Chat messages are stored within a database called "SMS.DB" located on the iPhone. The SMS database consists of a series of tables that store different pieces of data, that when combined make up an individual SMS message as well as an SMS thread or conversation.
14. An examination of the SMS database as located on the Ashby iPhone reveals that it contains a number of tables. The following sections provide details about some of these tables and some of the fields contained within them (please note this is not a complete list):

Message table

15. The message table contains the content of each SMS message as well as details of the sender or recipient, the message thread that the message belongs to, and the status of the message. The following table summarises some of these properties:

| Table: Message | |

| Field name | Description |
| ROWID | This is a unique sequential number that is assigned to each new message sent or received |
| address | This is the phone number of the sender or the phone number of who the message is being sent to. As the message originates from the Ashby iPhone, the iPhone number does not appear in this field. |
| date | This is the date and time the message is sent or received. |

| text | This is the actual text of the message either sent or received. |
| flags | The flags field contains a predefined number that provides an indication as to the state of the message (e.g. Sent, Received or Deleted) |
| group_id | The group_id is a unique number assigned to a collection of messages that form a conversation. The group_id helps identify all messages that form part of given conversation between the same senders and receivers. A variation to the sender or receiver will result in a new message conversation being created and a new group_id being assigned. |

Message Group table

16. The message group table contains details about different message groups. As noted above a message group is essentially a series of SMS messages that belong to a particular conversation (or thread) between the same group of senders and receivers. The message group table helps identify each message group by way of a unique number and the unique number of the most recent message added to each message group. The following table summarises some of these properties:

| Table: msg_group | |
|------------------|---|
| Field name | Description |
| ROWID | This is a unique-sequential number that is assigned to each message group. |
| newest_message | The newest message field contains the unique ID number of the most recent message that has been added to a message group. |
| unread_count | This is the total number of messages within a given message group that have not been read. |

Group Member table

17. The "group_member" table contains details of each phone number that belongs to a given conversation group. The following table summarises some of the details contained in the "group_member" table;

| Table: group_member | |
|---------------------|--|
| Field name | Description |
| ROWID | This is a unique sequential number assigned to each record in the "group_member" table. |
| group_id | The group_id is a unique number assigned to a collection of messages that form a conversation. The group_id helps identify all messages that form part of given conversation between the same senders and receivers. |
| address | This is the phone number that is associated with the given group ID. |

18. When the iPhone is backed up by the iTunes software, the SMS database is included in the backup which is stored on the PC or Apple computer on which the backup is performed.

Testing the integrity of the SMS database on the Ashby iPhone

19. To test the integrity of the SMS database as located on the Ashby iPhone, we have focussed our analysis on the content of the "message" and the "msg_group" tables. The following sections detail the testing performed and the results of these tests.

Effecting changes

20. To make changes to the content of the SMS database, it would, in the first instance, be necessary to extract the SMS database from the iTunes backup. Once extracted the SMS database, subject to the comments below, could be manipulated, and then reinserted back into the iTunes backup. In reinserting the modified SMS database backup into the iTunes backup, various control values within the iTunes backup would need to be modified to reflect the fact that a modified SMS database has been inserted. Failure to do this would see the restoration of the modified iTunes backup to the iPhone fail.
21. The presence of these control values makes a direct manipulation of the SMS backup within an iTunes backup set problematic. We note that there are third party programs that will permit the extraction and insertion of the SMS database within the iTunes backup in such a manner so as to take into account the impact of the control values.
22. The following tests have been performed assuming that such a third party program has been used.

Message sequencing

23. Message sequencing relies on the way new messages are inserted into the "message" table. When a new message is sent or received, it is inserted at the end of the "message" table as a new record. As a consequence of this the message receives the next sequential value which is tracked in a table called "sqlite_sequence".
24. An examination of the sequence of messages should reveal that the date and time values as well as the ROWID values should increment as one moves through the "message" table from the earliest messages to the latest messages.
25. In the event that a message were manually "inserted" into the "message" table through the use of a third party program, it is possible that the chronological sequence of message dates and times would be impacted resulting in an out of sequence event.
26. An examination of those messages referred to in the Ashby application as located in the Ashby iPhone SMS database does not reveal any sequencing anomalies.

Message count

27. As noted above, the "msg_group" table contains a field called "newest_message" which records the most recent message id for a given message-group. An examination of the SMS database shows that there are a series of "triggers" active. A "trigger" is a small set of instructions inserted into a database that initiate a process in the event that a given event occurs. In the case of the "message" database, when a new message is inserted a "trigger" is activated that updates the value in the "newest_message" field to reflect the message id for the inserted message.
28. Where a condition within a "trigger" is not met, the insertion of a new record will fail.
29. We note that the "newest_message" value for each of the groups listed in the "msg_group" table corresponds with the highest message ID value identified for each group in the "messages" table. The absence of any mismatch between these numbers is consistent with a record being inserted for a given group and the associated "trigger" being activated as per normal operation of the SMS database.

Trigger removal

30. To circumvent the effects of the "triggers", it is possible, through the use of third party software, to remove the "triggers" embedded within a database. Once removed changes could be made which would not ordinarily be permitted had the "trigger" been present. On completion of any change the "trigger" could be reinstated within the database.
31. We note that even with the "triggers" removed, the SMS database will continue to function within the iPhone, albeit that the actions performed by the "triggers" will not take effect. In the case of the earlier example, if the "trigger" that updates the "newest_message" value is removed, the SMS database will continue to permit new messages to be inserted however the update to the "newest_message" value will not occur.
32. Whilst we are unable to ascertain if a "trigger" has been removed, a message inserted, and the "trigger" reinserted, we do note that the SMS database from the Ashby iPhone does contain active "triggers" which is consistent with the normal operations of the phone.

Group member validation

33. A comparison of all Group ID values from the "group_member" table against the Group ID values within the "msg_group" table was performed. The purpose being to ascertain if any group ID's may have been inserted manually without consideration of the correct record keeping operations of the SMS database.
34. The comparison reveals that the "group_member" table and "msg_group" table contain identical group ID's, which is consistent with the normal operations of the SMS database.

General comments


35. It should be noted that in order for a person to insert a new SMS message, the following conditions would need to be met:
- a) The person would need to have a detailed knowledge of the structure and operations of the SMS database. Such knowledge is not readily obtained due to the lack of publically available documentation relating to the operations of the SMS database.
 - b) The insertion of a new SMS message would require the removal of predefined "triggers" which in turn requires a detailed knowledge of the workings of the SMS database.
 - c) The insertion of a new SMS message into an existing message group would require updates to be made to the message table, and message group table.
 - d) The insertion of a new SMS message group and associated messages would require updates to be made to the message table, message group table and group member table.
 - e) The insertion of a new SMS message would need to take into account the impact on the message sequencing and message count.

Findings

36. Based on the testing as detailed above, we are unable to identify any indicators that would suggest that the SMS database as extracted from the Ashby iPhone has had SMS messages manually inserted.

I, Kamna Muddagouni, of 456 Lonsdale Street, Melbourne, Trainee Lawyer, affirm:

1. I am a trainee lawyer in the employ of Maurice Blackburn Lawyers (**Maurice Blackburn**), which represents the Second Respondent in this proceeding (**the Proceeding**).
2. The statements set out in this affidavit are made from my information, knowledge and belief based on instructions given to me by the Second Respondent or from my own personal knowledge.

Preparation of First Chart of Text Messages


3. On Monday 2 July 2012, I was instructed by Siobhan Keating, Special Counsel at Maurice Blackburn, (**Keating**) to assist her with amending an Excel Spreadsheet of SMS, MMS and iChat messages.
4. I was informed by Keating that Maurice Blackburn was acting for the Second Respondent in an interlocutory application seeking, among other things, a permanent stay of the Proceeding on the basis that the Proceeding was an abuse of process (**the Interlocutory Application**).
5. Keating instructed me to amend an Excel Spreadsheet prepared by Emeline Gaske, a solicitor employed by Maurice Blackburn (**Gaske**). The spreadsheet Gaske had prepared was a record of various SMS, MMS and chat messages. Keating emailed me a copy of this spreadsheet. I have seen the affidavit of Keating filed in support of the Interlocutory Application and affirmed on 12 June 2012 and can confirm that the spreadsheet provided to me is annexure SK-22 to that affidavit (**Spreadsheet SK-22**).
6. Keating instructed me to add to Spreadsheet SK-22 records of SMS, MMS and iChat messages which were referred to in the Second Respondent's Amended Points of Claim (**the Points of Claim**) filed on 26 June 2012, but which did not otherwise already appear in Spreadsheet SK-22.
7. Keating handed me the CD labelled RDM-3 (**the CD**). Keating told me the CD contained an Excel spreadsheet with records of SMS, MMS and iChat messages from the mobile phone of the Applicant (**Ashby**). Keating informed me, and I

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believe, that this CD was exhibited to an affidavit of Rodney David McKemmish sworn 24 April 2012 (the McKemmish affidavit) which was provided to the Second Respondent by Ashby on or about Monday 28 May 2012, pursuant to an order of the Court made on 18 May 2012. Exhibited hereto and marked as KM-1 is the CD marked as Exhibit RDM-3 to the McKemmish Affidavit.

8. I inserted the CD which Keating had given me into the disk drive of my computer in my office at Maurice Blackburn (my computer). I observed on the screen of my computer that the CD contained an Excel file. I opened the Excel file by using the latest version of Excel. I did so by remotely logging onto the new Excel 2010 through a remote access system called Citrix. I then logged onto this system remotely on my computer and then opened the Excel file contained in the CD. When I opened the Excel file I observed an Excel spreadsheet consisting of a number of tabs, including
9. tabs labelled "Messages SMS", "Messages MMS", and "Messages Chat" (the Excel Spreadsheet). There were hundreds of messages in each tab.
10. I also opened the file comprising Spreadsheet SK-22 on my computer screen.
11. In order to complete the task I was instructed to do by Keating, I carefully reviewed the Points of Claim and made a note of all SMS, MMS and iChat messages either sent from or received on the Applicant's phone that were referred to in the Points of Claim. The Points of Claim identified each such SMS, MMS or iChat message by reference to the number assigned to each message in the Excel Spreadsheet.
12. I then carefully checked and noted all SMS, MMS and iChat messages referred to in the Points of Claim that were not included in Spreadsheet SK-22.
13. Having identified all SMS, MMS and iChat messages referred to in the Points of Claim that were not included in Spreadsheet SK-22, and using the "copy and paste" function of the Excel program, I then copied the content of each of those messages as they appeared in the Excel Spreadsheet and pasted them at the end of the file comprising Spreadsheet SK-22 on my computer screen. In this regard I copied and pasted the following data for each of the messages: (1) the status of the message as having been read or sent, (2) the telephone number to which the message was sent or from which it was received, (3) the actual text of the


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
message, and (4) the date and time on or at which the message was sent or received. I copied all of this information directly from the Excel Spreadsheet.

14. For each text message added, I also identified the name of either the person to whom the message was sent or from whom the message was received and included this data under the column "Name". In order to perform this task, I compared and matched the telephone number of the message I was adding to Spreadsheet SK-22 with telephone numbers already identified in Spreadsheet SK-22 in order to identify the name of the person associated with each telephone number. I added a total of 222 messages to Spreadsheet SK-22 (the additional messages).
15. As a part of this task, I also added another column to Spreadsheet SK-22 which set out the reference number associated with each message as it appeared in the Excel Spreadsheet. In order to do this, I cross-referenced each message from Spreadsheet SK-22 with the same message as it appeared in the Excel Spreadsheet and then copied and pasted the relevant reference number into Spreadsheet SK-22.
16. In the course of the process described above I did not in any way alter the content of the messages as they appeared in the Excel Spreadsheet. Spreadsheet SK-22 as amended by me in the manner described above is annexure SK-1 to the affidavit of

Keating filed in support of the Interlocutory Application and affirmed on 2 July 2012 (Spreadsheet SK-1).

Preparation of Spreadsheet of messages in chronological order


17. On around 11 July 2012, Keating forwarded me an email which sought clarification on some possible errors in Spreadsheet SK-1. The errors identified related to three messages that had the incorrect reference number identified in the Reference column.
18. On around 11 July 2012, Keating asked me to verify and correct the errors identified by counsel by comparing the Excel Spreadsheet and Spreadsheet SK-1.
19. In order to do this, on 12 July 2012, I opened the Excel file on RDM-3 through the process using remote access login I described above. I then opened Spreadsheet SK-1. I identified the three messages with the suspected incorrect reference numbers and was able to see that they in fact did have the wrong reference

number. I then corrected the reference number in relation to these three messages, by copying the correct reference number from the Excel Spreadsheet and pasting it into Spreadsheet SK-1. The correct reference numbers now appear in the annexure to this affidavit referred to below, namely, reference numbers 15284, 15286 and 15287.


20. On 12 July 2012, Keating instructed me to also organise and sort all of the messages in Spreadsheet SK-1 into chronological order. I was instructed by Keating that Spreadsheet SK-22 was in chronological order and that when I had added the additional messages which had been referred to in the Points of Claim, as described in paragraph 11 above, Spreadsheet SK-1 was no longer in chronological order.
21. In order to complete this task, using the "cut and paste" function of the Excel program, I cut the additional messages from Spreadsheet SK-1 and pasted them in a blank spreadsheet that I created using the Excel program (the temporary spreadsheet). I then went through these messages in the temporary spreadsheet and ordered them into chronological order by cutting and pasting the relevant rows with messages into order by the Date/Time column.
22. I then reviewed the Spreadsheet SK-1 (with the additional messages having been removed as described above) and inserted rows into Spreadsheet SK-1 wherever there needed to be messages added from the temporary spreadsheet in accordance with chronological order. I then cut these rows of messages from the temporary spreadsheet and pasted them into the newly inserted rows of Spreadsheet SK-1. I repeated this process for each of the additional messages. Once this process was completed, I went through all of the 540 messages in the re-ordered Spreadsheet SK-1 and observed that they were all in chronological order by checking the date and time on or at which each message was sent or received as it appeared in the 'Date/Time' column of the spreadsheet. Annexed hereto and marked KM-2 is a copy of Spreadsheet SK-1 as modified by me in the manner described in paragraphs 17 to 22.
23. There are three messages, Message 150, Message 309 and Message 385, in annexure KM-2 which cannot be shown in its entirety in the Excel Spreadsheet format. Annexed hereto and marked KM-3 is Microsoft Word document shows Message 385 separately and in its entirety. I created this word document by using the "copy and paste" function of the Excel program, and copying each column


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
relating to Message 385 separately and pasting it in a blank word document. Annexed hereto and marked KM-4 is Microsoft Word document shows Message 309 separately and in its entirety. I created this word document by using the "copy and paste" function of the Excel program, and copying each column relating to Message 309 separately and pasting it in a blank word document. Annexed hereto and marked KM-5 is Microsoft Word document shows Message 150 separately and in its entirety. I created this word document by using the "copy and paste" function of the Excel program, and copying each column relating to Message 150 separately and pasting it in a blank word document.





2. The statements set out in this affidavit are made from my own personal knowledge unless otherwise indicated.
3. I performed the work set out below under the direction of Siobhan Keating (Keating), Special Counsel at Maurice Blackburn, between about 6 June 2012 and about 11 June 2012.

Preparation of Annexure SK-22

4. On or about 6 June 2012 Siobhan Keating, Special Counsel at Maurice Blackburn (Keating), handed to me two CDs labelled RDM-2 and RDM-3. Keating informed me, and I believe, that those CDs were exhibited to an affidavit of Rodney David McKemmish sworn 24 April 2012 (the McKemmish affidavit) which was provided to the Second Respondent by the Applicant (Ashby) on or about Monday 28 May 2012, pursuant to an order of the Court made on 18 May 2012, and that the McKemmish affidavit was referred to in Ashby's Originating Application. Exhibited hereto and marked "EG-1" is the CD labelled RDM-2 referred to above. Exhibited hereto and marked "EG-2" is the CD labelled RDM-3 referred to above.
5. Keating advised me that Maurice Blackburn intended to file an Interlocutory Application on behalf of the Second Respondent seeking, among other things, an order to permanently stay the Proceeding on the grounds that it constituted an abuse of process (the Interlocutory Application).
6. Keating directed me to review the material on the CDs and prepare a spreadsheet of SMS, MMS and chat messages that I considered relevant to the Interlocutory Application. Keating advised me that relevant material included any communications in the period 1 January 2012 through to 12 April 2012 that demonstrated that, by instituting the Proceeding, Ashby intended to:
 - (a) damage the reputation of the Second Respondent; and/or
 - (b) aid the political opponents of the Second Respondent, in particular, the Liberal National Party of Queensland and/or Mr Malcolm Brough.
7. Based on my review of the material contained on the CDs labelled RDM-2 and RDM-3, and in accordance with the instructions provided to me by Keating, I created a spreadsheet setting out the information stored in the CDs labelled RDM-2 and RDM-3 provided to me by Keating. That spreadsheet is annexure SK-22 to the affidavit of Keating filed in support of the Interlocutory Application and affirmed on 12 June 2012 (Spreadsheet SK-22).
8. I created Spreadsheet SK-22 by taking the following steps between about 6 June 2012 and about 11 June 2012:

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- (a) On or about 6 June 2012 Keating said to me words to the following effect: "the material on RDM-2 is in a format that I cannot open on my computer, you will need to ask IT for assistance".
- (b) I attended the office of Mr David Greening (**Greening**), IT Operations Manager at Maurice Blackburn. I gave Greening the CD labelled RDM-2 and said to Greening words to the following effect: "there is a file on this CD we cannot open, can you please assist me to open it." I also said to Greening words to the following effect: "the material relates to the case against Peter Slipper, it is the iPhone of the man who is suing him, it is very sensitive".
- (c) While I was in Greening's office I saw him insert the disc labelled RDM-2 into his computer. Shortly after inserting the disc into the computer he said to me words to the following effect: "it is an XRY file, I don't think we have a program that reads that type of file, let me see if I can find one". After about 5 minutes Greening said to me words to the following effect: "I have found an XRY file reader, I am just downloading it now". I stood behind Greening and saw him download and install the XRY file reader to his computer. An XRY file is a computer program that stores data contained in mobile phones.
- (d) Once the XRY file reader was installed, I saw Greening open a file saved on the CD labelled RDM-2. Greening used the XRY file reader and showed me how to view SMS messages, MMS messages and images stored on the disc labelled RDM-2. In doing so, Greening and I viewed some of the material stored on the phone, including a few SMS and MMS messages and about 5 images saved on the phone. I then asked Greening to install the XRY program on my computer in my office at Maurice Blackburn (**my computer**).
- (e) Later that day Greening attended my office and told me he was there to install the XRY file reader program. At the time I was sitting in my chair in front of my computer. I got out of my chair and saw Greening sit in my chair. I then left my office. I came back into my office about five minutes later, and Greening said to me words to the following effect: "I have finished installing the XRY file reader programme". Greening then left my office. I sat back in front of my computer and saw that the XRY file reader programme was open on the screen of my computer.
- (f) I inserted the CD labelled RDM-3 into the hard drive of my computer. I cannot recall the process by which I arrived at the contents screen, but at some point soon after inserting RDM-3 my computer screen displayed the contents of the disc


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

labelled RDM-3. I saw that there was a single Excel file. I clicked on the Excel icon, and the file opened. I saw that the file was an Excel spreadsheet consisting of a number of tabs, including tabs labelled "Messages SMS" (the SMS Tab), "Messages MMS", and "Messages Chat" (the Chat Tab). I scrolled through the tabs. There were hundreds of messages in each tab. I then saved a copy of the Excel spreadsheet contained in RDM-3 to the hard drive of my computer. I did not alter in any way the content of the SMS Tab or the Chat Tab in this process. I simply saved that Excel document to my hard drive in the form in which it appeared in the CD labelled RDM-3.

(g) I then removed the CD labelled RDM-3 from my computer and inserted the CD labelled RDM-2. The XRY file reader programme allowed me to open the files stored on the disc labelled RDM-2. To the best of my recollection I clicked on an "open" button, and I was able to select files on the disc labelled RDM-2 to open. I recall there were two files saved on the disc. I opened each of the files in turn. The XRY program enabled me to view the information stored in RDM-2 through an interface which permitted me to read the information in those files. The information contained in those files consisted of call logs, SMS messages (the SMS folder), MMS messages (the MMS folder), Chat messages (the Chat folder) and a range of other technical data. The file also contained the "contacts" data stored on the iPhone (the Contacts folder) which set out the names of persons recorded as "contacts" on the phone, together with telephone numbers, email addresses and other contact details associated with those names.


(h) I used the "export" function of the XRY file reader program and transferred the data stored in the SMS folder on one of the files stored on the disc labelled RDM-2 to an Excel spreadsheet (the SMS Spreadsheet). I also transferred the data contained in the Chat folder in that same file to an Excel spreadsheet (the Chat Spreadsheet). To the best of my recollection I reviewed the material stored in the SMS folder and the Chat folder in the second file saved on the disc labelled RDM-2 and observed that the material contained in that folder was also contained in the SMS and Chat folders of the first file.

(i) I saved the SMS Spreadsheet to the hard drive of my computer and the Chat Spreadsheet was saved on the Maurice Blackburn server. I compared a random selection of messages contained in the SMS Spreadsheet with the messages contained in the SMS tab of the Excel Spreadsheet contained on RDM-3. To the best of my recollection, the messages that I checked were identical.


- (j) To the best of my recollection, I used the SMS Tab and the Chat Tab of the Excel spreadsheet contained in the disc labelled RDM-3 (which was now saved on my computer hard drive) to identify relevant communications for the purpose of creating Spreadsheet SK-22.
- (k) I then used the "export" function of the XRY file reader to transfer the data stored in the Contacts folder to an Excel spreadsheet (the Contacts spreadsheet).
- (l) I then searched the SMS Tab and the Chat Tab of the spreadsheets in RDM-3 to identify all communications that in my opinion appeared relevant to the Interlocutory Application for the period 1 January 2012 through to 12 April 2012 (the relevant communications).
- (m) Where I identified a relevant communication (sometimes in consultation with Ms Keating), I copied it into Spreadsheet SK-22 by using the "copy" and "paste" functions in Excel.
- (n) One of the columns in each of the SMS and Chat tabs contained the phone number that the communication was sent to or was received from. I searched the Contacts Spreadsheet for each of the numbers appearing next to a relevant communication using the "Ctrl-F" search function in Excel. By this means I identified the name entered into Ashby's contacts list that matched each phone number to which, or from which, relevant communications were recorded as having been sent or received. I then typed the name of the person who was associated with the particular telephone number in the Contacts Spreadsheet into the first column of Spreadsheet SK-22. By this means I matched the following telephone numbers appearing in the SMS Tab and the Chat Tab with the following persons:
- i. [REDACTED] - Mark MacArdle, which I took to be a misspelling of the name 'Mark McArdle';
 - ii. [REDACTED] - Steve Lewis;
 - iii. [REDACTED] - Karen Doane; and
 - iv. [REDACTED] - Anthony McClellan.
- (o) On or about 6 June 2012 Keating told me that she had telephoned the number [REDACTED] and had confirmed that the telephone number was that of Mr Malcolm Brough. At Keating's direction, I inserted the name 'Mal Brough' into the



first column of Spreadsheet SK-22 next to communications that were sent to, or received from, the telephone number [REDACTED]. I also inserted the name 'Mal Brough' next to communications that were sent to, or received from the email address mal.brough2@bigpond.com.

(p) I then reviewed the Chat Tab. The SMS and Chat tabs identified the time and date that each message was sent or received. Where I copied and pasted a communication from the Chat Tab into Spreadsheet SK-22, I reviewed the time and date that it was sent or received and ensured it was pasted into Spreadsheet SK-22 such that all relevant communications from both the SMS and Chat Spreadsheets appeared chronologically.

9. Once I identified every message that I considered to be relevant, I formatted the spreadsheet in a way that made it easily read and understood. For example, I moved the "read/sent" column such that it appeared before the content of the message. I also reformatted the font type and size.
10. In the course of the process described above I did not in any way alter the content of the messages as they appeared in the SMS Tab and the Chat Tab as saved on my hard drive directly from the CD labelled RDM-3. The content of each message remained identical to the message as it appeared in the SMS Tab and the Chat Tab contained in the spreadsheet saved on the CD labelled RDM-3 and from which it had been copied as described above.
11. I observed that some of the messages included a nonsensical line of text. Based on my personal use of computers and mobile phones, I believe that the nonsensical line of text is the representation of an "emoticon" from the original text message. An "emoticon" is a graphic that is used to display a particular emotion (such as happiness, surprise, anger) in communications such as text messages and emails. I did not make any changes to the nonsensical text representing emoticons.
12. I then sent an email to Keating attaching a link to Spreadsheet SK-22. I am told by Keating, and believe that Keating made further stylistic changes to the spreadsheet, but did not change the content of the messages.
13. The XRY file reader has a function which allows the user to print MMS messages that were sent to or from the iPhone. I reviewed all MMS messages saved on RDM-2, and printed all of those that I considered to be relevant to the proceeding. Those messages





15. On 17 July 2012 Keating told me, and I believe, that no copies of the CDs labelled RDM-2 and RDM-3 have been made. I did not make any copies of RDM-2 or RDM-3. Keating also told me, and I believe, that the only copy of each of those CDs in the power, possession or control of Maurice Blackburn are those that were exhibited to the McKemmish affidavit and provided to Maurice Blackburn by Ashby's solicitors.


