

# 6. I currently have a number of FOI applications which have been referred to the IC for merit review, including one that has been with the IC for more than a year, of which one has been with the IC for more than 18 months, and one for more than two years.

- 7. I believe that each of the FOI applications referred to in paragraph 6 relate to matters of significant public importance.
- 8. The effect of these delays has been to prevent me from accessing the relevant documents or from lodging an application for review under paragraph 57A(1)(a) of the FOI Act. This

has, in turn, hindered me in performing my role as a Federal Member of Parliament which includes scrutinising, discussing commenting and reviewing the Government's activities.
