This genuine steps statement is required by section 6 of the *Civil Dispute Resolution Act 2011*.

Steps taken to try to resolve the issues in dispute

The following steps have been taken to try to resolve the issues in dispute between the Applicants and the Respondents in the proceeding:

- 1 On 4 March 2026, HWLE Lawyers (**HWLE**), solicitors for the Applicants, sent a letter to Herbert Smith Freehills Kramer (**HSF Kramer**), solicitors for the Respondents. In the correspondence:
 - (a) the Respondents were put on notice of the allegations to be made by the Applicants, and the nature of the remedies sought;
 - (b) the Respondents were invited to cause a rescission and issue of a correction to the market announcement made by the directors of the Second Respondent and published on the Australian Securities Exchange's website on 3 March 2026 (**ASX Market Announcement**); and
 - (c) the Respondents were invited to immediately rescind their purported termination of the Broadcast Services Agreement (**Agreement**) between the parties.
- 2 On 9 March 2026, HSF Kramer replied to the correspondence set out in paragraph [1] above. In this reply:

- (a) the Respondents refused to cause a correction to the ASX Market Announcement as requested;
 - (b) the Respondents declined the Applicant's invitation to rescind its termination of the Agreement;
 - (c) the Respondents otherwise denied the allegations made against them; and
 - (d) HSF Kramer indicated that it had instructions to accept service of any Court processes.
- 3 The Applicants have taken genuine steps reasonably available to them to resolve the dispute prior to commencing this proceeding.
