**RELIEF SOUGHT:**

1. Pursuant to ss 33Y and 33ZF of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth) (**Act**), the Court approves a variation of the Registration Process approved by orders 1, 2 and 6 made on 16 September 2024 (**16 September Orders**) such that the registration deadline of 31 August 2025 for the purposes of clause 2.2.1 of the Deed of Settlement dated 30 August 2024 is extended to 30 November 2025, or such later date as the Court may by subsequent order specify (**Extended Registration Date**).
2. Pursuant to ss 33X and 33Y of the Act, the Court approves an amendment to the form and content of the Brochure approved by order 1 of the 16 September Orders to substitute the Registration Date with "30 November 2025 (unless further extended by the Court)" (**Updated Brochure**).
3. Further to orders 7 to 17 of the 16 September Orders:
 - (a) the Applicant, by her solicitor Shine Lawyers will:
 - (i) replace the Brochure published on its website pursuant to order 12 of the 16 September Orders with the Updated Brochure;
 - (ii) cause the fact of the Extended Registration Dates to be published by radio and other means in such other manner as Shine Lawyers consider will best bring it to the attention of Group Members; and
 - (b) the Respondent will replace the Brochure published on its website pursuant to Order 13 of the 16 September Orders,

but the steps required by Orders 7 to 17 of the 16 September Orders are otherwise not required to be repeated.
