Details of cross-claim

On the grounds stated in the statement of cross-claim the Cross-claimants claim:

1. Damages from the Second Cross-Respondent (**Quasar**) for breach of the Broadcast Services Agreement between the First Cross-claimant (**CBC**) and Quasar dated 21 November 2023 (**Quasar BSA**).
2. Orders requiring Quasar to, and declaring that Quasar is liable to, indemnify the Cross-claimants in respect of expenses, losses, liabilities, damages or costs arising out of uncured breaches of the Quasar BSA, and breach of statute.
3. An order requiring Quasar to pay CBCan amount in debt.
4. A declaration that CBC validly terminated the Broadcast Services Agreement between CBC and the Fourth and Fifth Cross-respondents dated 30 October 2023.
5. Orders pursuant to section 51A of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth) for pre-judgment interest.
6. Costs, including interest on costs.
7. Such further or other relief as the Court deems fit.
