I, Carlo Boumouglbay, say on oath:

Introduction

1. This is the second affidavit I have sworn in this proceeding. My first affidavit was sworn on 15 December 2025 (**First Affidavit**).
2. In this affidavit, I use the same defined terms used in my First Affidavit.

September 2023

3. At paragraphs 13 and 14 of my First Affidavit, I said:

13. *Charlotte came to visit me while I was working on Mamma Mia. She was due to start rehearsals and prerecords in September 2023 in Sydney for the Film. She was going to fly from Brisbane to Sydney to do some pre-production work and then the production team was going to fly her back to*

Albany, in Western Australia, where she lived, and then return to Sydney to shoot the Film.

14. *While Charlotte was with me in Brisbane, her agent called her to say that Amanda Ghost, one of the producers of the Film, had invited Charlotte to stay with her and her assistant (Pia Ashcroft) in Sydney at an apartment at Bondi Beach to avoid the travel.*
4. On 3 September 2023, Charlotte left Brisbane for Sydney. While she was in Sydney doing pre-production and production for the Film, we spoke by phone most days.
5. In the evening of 5 September 2023, Charlotte called me and said words to the effect that she and Amanda had gone for a swim at the beach and Amanda had had a bad reaction to the cold water. She said she had helped Amanda back to the apartment. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Charlotte told me that they both ended up in a huge bath to warm up. She said Pia Ashcroft was also present. She told me that Rebel Wilson was also on the phone at some stage. Charlotte was completely calm when recounting these events to me. She never once suggested anything about being uncomfortable.
6. The next day, 6 September 2023, when Charlotte and I spoke again, she said she had gone to the studio where the pre-records were taking place and she and Amanda had told the cast and Rebel what had happened the day prior.
7. In the week or so after this Charlotte had said to me that Amanda seemed to be avoiding her. Charlotte didn't know why.
8. On 14 September 2023, Charlotte phoned me to tell me she had been asked to leave the apartment. She told me she was confused as to the reason why, but that she felt very alone. She said she thought she had ruined her relationship with Amanda but did not know how.
9. On 18 September 2023, Charlotte told me that her agent Monica had been informed that Charlotte had been told to leave the apartment because she felt uncomfortable with Amanda. Charlotte was really confused by this. At first, she wasn't sure if there had been some sort of misunderstanding. But she also started to be suspicious, and thought Rebel might be spreading misinformation about her and spinning some type of story. Eventually, she came to think Rebel was twisting the story.
10. I then flew to Sydney on 25 September 2023 to be with Charlotte. I took a few days off work with Mamma Mia to support her. Charlotte and I discussed what had happened and she told me (and I could see that) she was very upset that Rebel had made this false claim about her.

- 11. In our phone discussions subsequently, Charlotte often mentioned that Rebel had been dismissive and disrespectful towards her and that this made her feel very isolated whilst on set.
- 12. Charlotte has never indicated to me that Amanda had ever bullied or demeaned her.
- 13. Based on all my conversations with Charlotte, I know that she has at all times wanted the Film to be successfully released and has never attempted to block it being released or support other people blocking it being released.
