Interlocutory orders sought

1. An order pursuant to s 56 of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth) (the **Act**) and r 36.09 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth) (the **Rules**) that the Appellant, provide security for the Respondents' costs of and incidental to defending the appeal proceeding, by payment into court or in such other form as the Court may determine, in the sum of \$200,000.00, or to such monetary value as the Court may determine, within 42 days from the date of the order.
2. An order that the appeal proceeding be stayed as against both Respondents until the security for costs in order 1 above is provided.
3. An order that, if the Appellant fails to comply with order 1, the appeal proceeding be dismissed against both Respondents pursuant to s 56(4) of the Act and r 36.09(1)(c) of the Rules.
4. The Appellant pay the Respondents' costs of, and incidental to, this application.
5. Such further or other orders as the Court thinks fit.
