THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. By 4.00 pm on 6 June 2022, the applicant shall file and serve any evidence upon which he intends to rely for the determination of the separate question described in order 2 of the orders made on 8 December 2021 (**separate question**).
2. By 4.00 pm on 18 July 2022, the respondent shall file and serve any evidence upon which she intends to rely for the determination of the separate question.
3. By 4.00 pm on 8 August 2022, the applicant shall file and serve any evidence in reply.
4. By 4.00 pm on 8 August 2022, the applicant shall file and serve a written outline of submissions, limited to ten pages, and a list of authorities.
5. By 4.00 pm on 29 August 2022, the respondent shall file and serve a written outline of submissions, limited to fifteen pages, and a list of authorities.
6. By 4.00 pm on 12 September 2022, the applicant shall file and serve any written submissions in reply. The applicant's outline of submissions and any submissions in reply are together limited to fifteen pages in total.
7. By 4.00 pm on 22 September 2022, the applicant shall:
 - (a) file and serve a joint tender bundle and joint list of legislation and authorities to be relied upon at the hearing; and



(b) provide the court, by email to the Chambers of the Honourable Justice Wheelahan with a download link, with electronic copies of each authority, in text-recognised and enhanced, PDF format, titled with the full case name and citation.

8. The separate question is to be heard on 26 September 2022, on an estimate of two days.

9. Costs reserved.
