## THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Orders 1 and 4 to 7 of the order made on 25 October 2022 are set aside.
- 2. The hearing listed for 21 February 2023 is re-fixed to 10.15am on 20 March 2023, on an estimate of two days.
- 3. By 4.00 pm on 6 February 2023, the applicant file and serve:
  - (a) any further evidence upon which he intends to rely for the determination of the separate question described in order 2 of the orders made on 8 December 2021 (**separate question**); and
  - (b) a supplementary written outline of submissions limited to 10 pages and a list of authorities.
- 4. By 4.00 pm on 6 March 2023, the respondent file and serve:
  - (a) any further evidence upon which she intends to rely for the determination of the separate question; and
  - (b) a supplementary written outline of submissions limited to ten pages and a list of authorities.



- 5. By 4.00 pm on 13 March 2023, the Applicant file and serve any written submissions in reply, limited to five pages.
- 6. By 4.00 pm on 13 March 2023, the respondent file and serve any further, supplementary evidence upon which she intends to rely for the determination of the separate question.
- 7. By 4.00 pm on 15 March 2023, the respondent file a tender bundle and a joint list of legislation and authorities to be relied upon at the hearing in electronic form, which:
  - (a) includes electronic copies of each authority, in text-recognised and enhanced, PDF format, titled with the full case name and citation;
  - (b) are prepared in accordance with any instructions provided via email by the Associate to the Honourable Justice Wheelahan; and
  - (c) are otherwise prepared in accordance with relevant Practice Notes, including the eBooks Practice Note (GPN-eBooks).
