PENAL NOTICE

TO: ANY PERSON WHO IS AFFECTED BY ORDER 1

IF YOU (BEING THE PERSON BOUND BY THIS ORDER):

- (A) REFUSE OR NEGLECT TO DO ANY ACT WITHIN THE TIME SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDER FOR THE DOING OF THE ACT; OR
- (B) DISOBEY THE ORDER BY DOING AN ACT WHICH THE ORDER REQUIRES YOU NOT TO DO,

YOU WILL BE LIABLE TO IMPRISONMENT, SEQUESTRATION OF PROPERTY OR OTHER PUNISHMENT.

ANY OTHER PERSON WHO KNOWS OF THIS ORDER AND DOES ANYTHING WHICH HELPS OR PERMITS YOU TO BREACH THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER MAY BE SIMILARLY PUNISHED.

THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to s 17(4) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act*, the public be excluded from the hearing listed on 26 November 2021, other than by the following arrangement:



- (a) any member of the public is able to join the hearing via the Microsoft Teams platform by contacting my executive assistant by email in the manner indicated in the daily courts list;
- (b) members of the public who attend the hearing via the method in paragraph 1 of these orders do so on the condition that they are:
 - (i) permitted to observe or listen to the hearing but are in no circumstances permitted to participate in the hearing;
 - (ii) prohibited from making any recording or photographic record of the hearing or any part thereof by any means whatsoever; and
 - (iii) advise that any failure to observe the conditions in (a) and (b) may constitute a contempt of court and be punishable as such.
- (c) pursuant to s 47B of the Act, counsel be permitted to deliver oral submissions by way of internet connection at the hearing.
