I have provided the below statement to the Sunday Telegraph, attributed to a spokesperson at STC:

Sydney Theatre Company received a complaint alleging that Mr Geoffrey Rush had engaged in inappropriate behaviour. The Company received the complaint when Mr Rush's engagement with the Company had ended. The Company continues to work with the complainant to minimise the risk of future instances of the alleged behaviour occurring in its workplace. The complainant has requested that their identity be withheld. STC respects that request and for privacy reasons, will not be making any further comments.

I have left a message for the journalist to call me, just so I can stress to him that our main concern is the wellbeing of the complainant and that he should respect their privacy.
