- 1. My full name is Adam Wade Veale.
- 2. I am an accountant and registered tax agent, and am a director of Alleviate Group, an accounting firm based in Perth.
- 3. I have been friends with Ben Roberts-Smith since about 1993, when we went to high school together at Hale School, Perth.
- 4. I am aware that Ben received his Victoria Cross medal in January 2011. He thereafter commenced speaking professionally on the 'talking circuit', and from about 2012 to about 2014 I was his manager.
- 5. I have also been Ben's personal accountant since about 2005.
- 6. I am aware that Ben has issued defamation proceedings in relation to a number of articles published by The Sydney Morning Herald, The Age and Canberra Times newspapers. I recall reading the online article "Special Forces Rookie 'blooded' by executing an unarmed man" on or about 9 June 2018 or shortly thereafter. At the time of reading the article, I did not know who the soldier referred to in the article as 'Leonidas' was.
- 7. I also recall reading the online article headed "Beneath the bravery of our most decorated soldier" on or about 10 August 2018. That article made serious allegations about Ben, accusing him of being a war criminal, and of engaging in domestic violence. I consider myself a good friend of Ben's and regularly speak with him both as to personal and professional matters. In my opinion, Ben is a person of upmost

integrity. He is a loyal friend, a compassionate person and has extreme devotion to causes he believes in.

- 8. By reason of the allegations of war crimes made against Ben in the article of 10 August 2018, I also then understood the allegations made in the article of 9 June 2018 referred to above to also be about Ben.
- 9. I spoke with Ben shortly after the publication of the said article of 10 August 2018, and we had a conversation in words to the following effect:

Myself:

How are you feeling about what has been written about you?

Ben:

I am very angry. I can't believe what they have written about me. I feel that I am under attack. I'm not a war criminal and I did not hit the

woman.

Myself:

How are Emma and the kids handling this?

Ben:

Emma is very upset. I hope the girls won't be affected.

I could tell from the tone of my conversation with Ben that he was extremely upset and angry about what had been written in the said article about him.

10. I still regularly meet with many of my old school friends from Hale School. Prior to publication of the articles, amongst those friends who know that I am in contact with and friends with Ben, Ben had a reputation as being a decent and straight-talking person. Those friends also knew that Ben received the Victoria Cross medal, and amongst those friends, Ben had a reputation as being a brave and admirable person for what he did to receive the medal and in general for what he did as a member of the SAS, putting his life on the line to keep the rest of us safe. He also had a reputation for behaving in a gentlemanly and respectful manner towards women. Since publication of the articles, friends have said to me words to the following effect about Ben:

[&]quot;I guess he won't be in such demand anymore"

[&]quot;I'm sure he was just doing what he was sent over there to do"
